1. ADVANCED AIRWAY MANAGEMENT

- Needle cricothyroidotomy
- Surgical airway
- Airway "tricks of the trade"
- And will feature: familiarisation of equipment required, locating anatomical landmarks, practical procedures and pitfalls.

2. VASCULAR ACCESS

This workshop will focus on supporting with emergency vascular access when venous cannulation proves difficult including:

- Intraosseous devices such as:
Cook™ needle,
EZIO™
BIG™ and FAST1™
- Cannulation "tricks of the trade"
- And will feature: familiarisation of equipment required and associated hazards, insertion technique, required modifications to infusion methods pitfalls.

3. THORACIC WORKSHOP

This workshop will focus on the recognition and treatment of life-threatening thoracic conditions such as tension pneumothorax including:

- Needle decompression
- Emergency chest drain insertion
- And will feature: clinical assessment of the chest, locating anatomical landmarks, practical procedures and pitfalls.
